THE ADMINISTRATIVE TRIBUNAL,

Considering the complaint against the United Nations Food and Agriculture Organization (FAO) drawn up by Miss Norah Connolly on 11 October 1966;

- A. Considering that the aforesaid complainant prays for the rescinding of an amendment, dated 5 October 1965, to Rule 103.14 of the Organization concerning the non-resident allowance;
- B. Considering that by a communication dated April 1968 complainant states that she withdraws her complaint, and has thus withdrawn any claim with respect to the relief prayed for in her complaint, and that the respondent Organization has no further submission to make;

DECISION:

The withdrawal of suit by Miss Connolly is hereby recorded.
