

THIRTY-THIRD ORDINARY SESSION

In re FOX

Judgment No. 239

THE ADMINISTRATIVE TRIBUNAL,

Considering the complaint against the International Labour Organisation (ILO) drawn up by Mr. Robert Fox on 29 January 1974, the Organisation's reply of 26 April 1974 and the complainant's rejoinder of 8 May 1974;

A. Considering that in the aforesaid complaint the complainant asked the Tribunal to order the ILO, which had declined to do so, to regard the period from the termination of his appointment in Nepal (31 December 1971) to the beginning of his appointment in Turkey (November 1972) as leave without pay and so enable him, by remaining in continuous service, to continue his participation in the Joint Staff Pension Fund;

B. Considering that by letter of 9 July 1974 the complainant informed the Registrar of the Tribunal that since the date of filing his complaint the Organisation had agreed to his request and that he therefore wished to withdraw suit;

C. Considering that by letter of 14 August 1974 the Organisation informed the Registrar that it had no objection to the withdrawal of suit by the complainant;

D. Considering that the complainant withdraws suit unreservedly;

DECISION:

The withdrawal of suit by Mr. Fox is hereby recorded.
