## In re STOM-GARNIER

## Judgment No. 242

## THE ADMINISTRATIVE TRIBUNAL,

Considering the complaint against the European Organisation for the Safety of Air Navigation (EUROCONTROL) drawn up by Mrs. Marie-Anne Stom-Garnier on 17 January 1974 and the Organisation's reply of 15 February 1974;

A. Considering that in her complaint Mrs. Stom-Garnier contends that the reimbursement of her leave entitlement did not include the six additional days which she claims were due to her on account of age under the provisions of the Staff Regulations for the period from 1 January to 31 October 1973, the date of her resignation;

B. Considering that in its reply the Organisation states that since the submission of the complaint the Staff Regulations have been amended, that by decision of 7 February 1974 the complainant was given satisfaction, and that, in its view, the complaint is therefore now devoid of purpose;

C. Considering that by letter of 5 April 1974 to the Registry of the Tribunal the complainant stated that, having obtained satisfaction, she wished to withdraw suit;

D. Considering that by letter of 27 April 1974 the Organisation informed the Registry that it had no comment to make on the withdrawal of suit by Mrs. Stom-Garnier;

E. Considering that the complainant withdraws suit unreservedly;

**DECISION:** 

The withdrawal of suit by Mrs. Stom-Garnier is hereby recorded.
