

**FORTY-FIFTH ORDINARY SESSION**

***In re* VAN BODEGOM**

**Judgment No. 419**

THE ADMINISTRATIVE TRIBUNAL,

Considering the complaint brought against the European Patent Organisation (EPO) by Mr. Maarten Wouter van Bodegom on 7 December 1978;

A. Considering that the complainant asked the Tribunal to order the EPO to pay him a sum corresponding to 91 overtime hours performed by him in 1977 and not yet paid on 1 February 1978, appeal proceedings having been suspended at the request of the parties for the purpose of seeking a settlement;

B. Considering that by a letter dated 22 May 1980 to the Registrar of the Tribunal the complainant stated that the matter had been settled and that there was no purpose in his pursuing the complaint;

C. Considering that by a letter of 11 June 1980 the EPO informed the Registrar that it had no objection to withdrawal of the suit;

D. Considering that suit is unreservedly withdrawn.

DECISION:

The withdrawal of suit is hereby recorded.
