

**TENTH ORDINARY SESSION**

***In re* LEPRETRE**

**Judgment No. 58**

THE ADMINISTRATIVE TRIBUNAL,

Considering the complaint against the International Telecommunication Union drawn up by Mr. Leprêtre on 22 December 1961 and the Organisation's reply of 19 February 1962;

A. Considering that complainant prays for the quashing of a decision concerning his regrading, dated 7 April 1960, together with subsequent decisions not to submit the question of his grading to the sixteenth Session of the Administrative Council of the Union, and thereafter to refer the matter to the seventeenth Session of the Council without however submitting any recommendation as to grading or compensation for damages suffered as a result of the refusal to submit his case to the sixteenth Session of the Council during which effective action could have been taken regarding his grading;

B. Considering that, by letter addressed to the Secretary-General of the Union on 17 April 1962, complainant declared that he renounced the right to bring any suit against the International Telecommunication Union respecting the grading decision of 7 April 1960 and subsequent decisions relating to his grading and, as a result of an out of court settlement, waived any claim and withdrew any complaint whatsoever which he might make concerning the consequences of such decisions and requested the Secretary-General to communicate his decision to the President of the Tribunal, and furthermore that, in its conclusions of 19 April 1962 concerning the withdrawal of complainant's suit, the Organisation, having regard to the said out of court settlement, withdrew its earlier request for the dismissal of the complaint and asked instead that the complainant's withdrawal of suit should be officially recorded.

**DECISION:**

The Tribunal notifies the parties that Mr. Leprêtre's withdrawal of suit is hereby recorded.
