THE ADMINISTRATIVE TRIBUNAL,

Considering the application for review of Judgment 673 filed by Mr. Chandra Bhan Singh on 19 August 1985 and corrected on 24 September;

Considering Article II, paragraph 5, of the Statute of the Tribunal and Article 8, paragraph 3, of the Rules of Court;

Having examined the written evidence;

CONSIDERATIONS:
