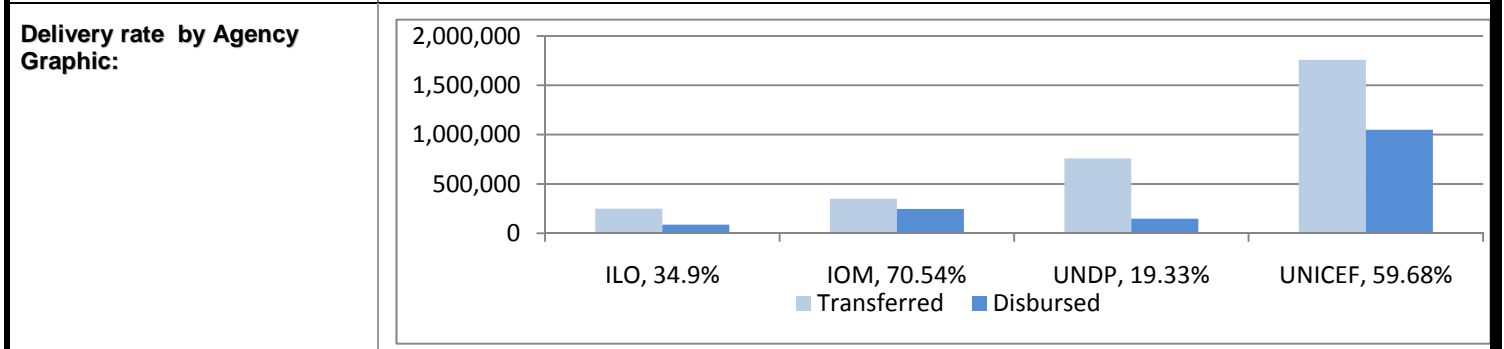

Status
 The joint programme faced a slow start and is currently gaining momentum. The programme shows visible progress and the mid-term evaluation is scheduled to take place in mid-September 2010.

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Main Achievements
Outcome 1: National hand pump policy drafted and submitted for approval to Government authorities; WASH MIS (SISAS) is in the consolidation phase with more than 70 percent of national data validated; supervision and capacity building held in all 18 provinces reaching 33 national and provincial staff; water works concluded in two communities of Cacuaco Municipality (10 water points providing water to 14,000 people and 11 water points under construction) ; field assessment done in Kilamba Kiayi Municipality and over 50 water points identified for rehabilitation in second half of 2010 and 60 municipal staff trained;. 10 water management groups (GAS) established in Cacuaco Municipality (Bairro de Pedreira); Community based management model (MOGECA) finalized with provisions to ensure effective participation of beneficiaries in water management; Baseline Study has been done and it is already approved by the PMC.
