- **270 million accidents**
- **2.2 million work-related deaths**
- **160 million work-related diseases**
- **4% of gross domestic product is lost**

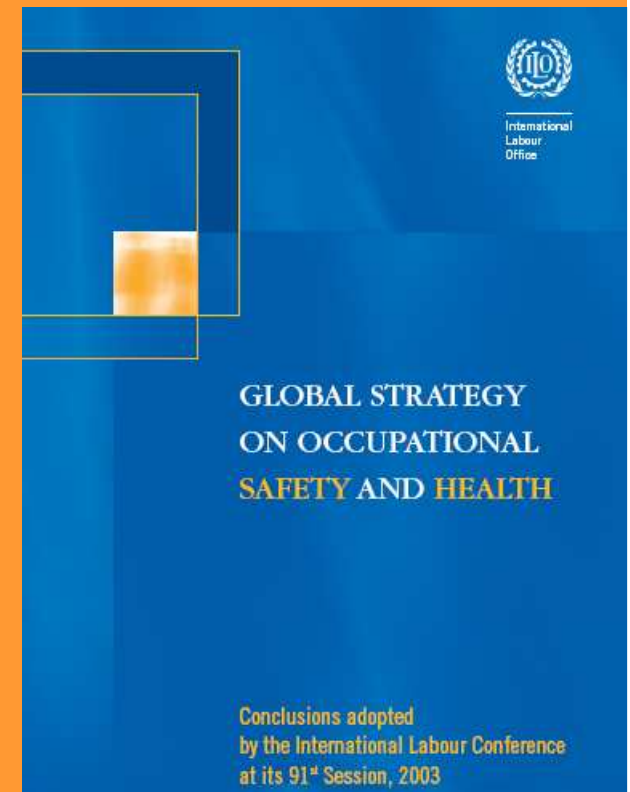

- Recognition of seven new CIS Centres since last CIS Annual Meeting (Düsseldorf, 2007)

- Irak (Baghdad), 2007
- Mauritania (Nouakchott), 2008

## 2) Collaborating Centres

- Russia (Saint-Petersburg), 2007
- Macedonia (Skopje), 2007
- Republika Srepska (Banja Luka), 2007
- Saoudi Arabia (Jeddah), 2007

# Coordination of the CIS Centres Network to June 2008

- Two existing centres (one in Perth (Australia) and one in Ouagadougou (Burkina Faso) have been revived
- Application from Senegal (2008)
- Request from Morocco to transfer the CIS Centres to the Ministry of Labour (beginning of 2008)

- A Regional meeting took place in Damascus (with the ILO Beirut Office, 18-20 Nov 2007)
- Request for a European/Mediterranean Rim Regional Meeting (September 2008, London)

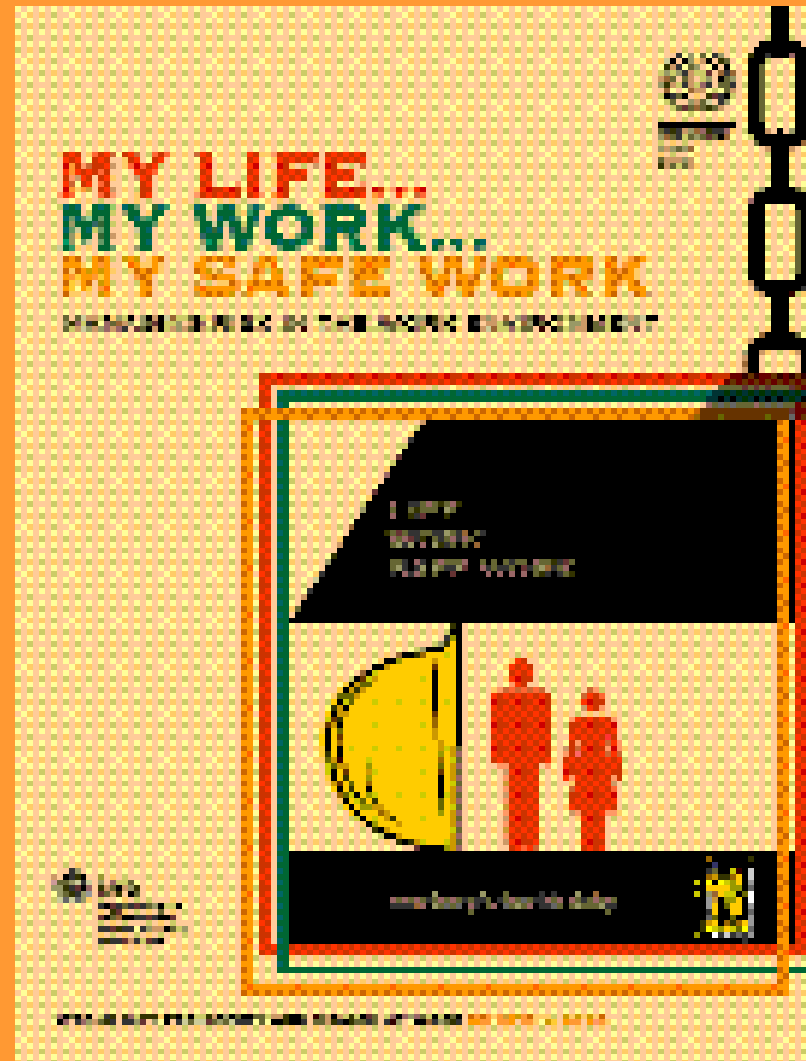

  - Europe
  - Francophone Africa
  - Russia

- 4) The OSH foresight system
