ACTIVITIES

✿ Safety Audits:

- Safety audit of oil & gas fields (exploration and production) to identify the hazardous practices.
- Follow-up with the company management for remedial action.

✿ Training Activities:

- Job related training to raise awareness about hydrogen sulfide, rescue work and statutory requirements.

ACTIVITIES (contd.)

✿ **Accident Investigation:**

- Investigation into fatal and major accidents to identify causes and suggest preventive measures.

✿ **Hazard Alert:**

- Occurrence of an incident/accident at one location is notified by specifying its causes to other companies.

ACTIVITIES (contd.)

❁ Information Dissemination:

- Circulation of “Asian-Pacific Newsletter” on Occupational Safety & Health.
- Notification of international OSH related events like seminars, workshops & training courses etc.

❁ Legislative Functions:

- Updating of OSH laws concerning oil and gas fields under process.
