



## FOURTH ITEM ON THE AGENDA

**Effect to be given to the recommendations  
of sectoral meetings****(a) Tripartite Meeting on the Social and Labour  
Dimensions of the Forestry and Wood  
Industries on the Move  
(Geneva, 17-21 September 2001)**

1. The Tripartite Meeting on the Social and Labour Dimensions of the Forestry and Wood Industries on the Move was held in Geneva from 17 to 21 September 2001, chaired by Mr. M. Arbesser-Rastburg (Employer member of the Governing Body).
2. The Meeting considered a [report](#) prepared by the International Labour Office.<sup>1</sup> It unanimously adopted a set of conclusions and two resolutions concerning future activities of the ILO and concerning social dialogue initiatives in the wood and forestry sectors.
3. The texts, together with a summary of the proceedings of the Meeting, appear in the [Note on the Proceedings](#), which is appended to the present paper.<sup>2</sup> Paragraphs 16-21 of the conclusions and the operative paragraphs of the resolutions call for action by the ILO.
4. *The Committee on Sectoral and Technical Meetings and Related Issues may wish to recommend that the Governing Body authorize the Director-General to communicate the Note on the Proceedings containing the texts mentioned in paragraph 3 above –*
  - (a) *to governments, requesting them to communicate these texts to the employers' and workers' organizations concerned;*
  - (b) *to the international employers' and workers' organizations concerned;*
  - (c) *to the other international organizations concerned.*
