**Effect to be given to the recommendations
of sectoral meetings****Tripartite Meeting on Civil Aviation: Social
and Safety Consequences of the Crisis
subsequent to 11 September 2001
(Geneva, 21-25 January 2002)**

1. The Tripartite Meeting on Civil Aviation: Social and Safety Consequences of the Crisis Subsequent to 11 September 2001, was held in Geneva from 21 to 25 January 2002, chaired by Mr. J. J. Elmiger (Government member of the Governing Body).
2. The Meeting considered an Issues paper prepared by the Office.¹ It unanimously adopted the Chairperson's final summary and a set of recommendations on fundamental principles and rights, safety and security, occupational health and safety, training and retraining, differential impact on men and women, restructuring, social dialogue and best practices in the civil aviation sector.
3. These texts, together with a summary of the proceedings of the Meeting, appear in the final report, which is appended to the present paper.² Paragraph 45 of the recommendations calls for certain action by the ILO.
4. *The Committee on Sectoral and Technical Meetings and Related Issues may wish to recommend that the Governing Body authorize the Director-General to communicate the Final report containing the texts mentioned in paragraph 3 above –*
 - (a) *to governments requesting them to communicate these texts to the employers' and workers' organizations concerned;*

(b) to the international employers' and workers' organizations concerned; and

(c) to the international organizations concerned.

- 5. *The Committee on Sectoral and Technical Meetings and Related Issues may wish to recommend that the Governing Body request the Director-General to bear in mind, when drawing up proposals for future work of the Office, the wishes expressed by the Meeting in paragraph 45 of the recommendations.***
