# (c) Meeting of Experts to Develop a Revised Code of Practice on Safety and Health in the Iron and Steel Industry

(Geneva, 1-9 February 2005)

- 1. The Meeting of Experts to Develop a Revised Code of Practice on Safety and Health in the Iron and Steel Industry was held in Geneva from 1 to 9 February, chaired by Mr. Edwin Friend, an external consultant.
- **2.** The experts reviewed and amended the draft revised code of practice on safety and health in the iron and steel industry. They also made a number of recommendations for follow-up action by the ILO.
- **3.** The experts unanimously adopted the new code of practice on safety and health in the iron and steel industry, <sup>1</sup> which will replace one adopted by a meeting of experts in 1981, as well as a report on their discussion. <sup>2</sup>
- 4. The Committee on Sectoral and Technical Meetings and Related Issues may wish to recommend that the Governing Body:
  - (a) take note of the report of the Meeting of Experts and authorize the Director-General to publish the code of practice on safety and health in the iron and steel industry;
  - (b) request the Director-General to bear in mind, when drawing up proposals for the future work of the Office, the wishes expressed by the Meeting in recommendations for follow-up action by the ILO.
