Conclusions on item GB.298/6: Measures taken by the Government of Belarus to implement the recommendations of the Commission of Inquiry established to examine the observance of the Freedom of Association and Protection of the Right to Organise Convention, 1948 (No. 87), and the Right to Organise and Collective Bargaining Convention, 1949 (No. 98)

The Governing Body:

- (1) noting the dialogue that has taken place, calls upon the Government of Belarus to fully cooperate with the International Labour Office for the implementation of all the recommendations of the Commission of Inquiry;
- (2) calls upon the Government to ensure that all workers' and employers' organizations can function freely and without interference, and obtain registration;
- (3) urges the Government to abandon the present draft concept on the trade union law and review all its legislation in full consultation with all the social partners concerned in order to ensure fully the right to organize both in law and in practice, in accordance with Convention No. 87, so that free and independent trade unions may exercise their full rights;
- (4) decides to keep the developments under close review.
