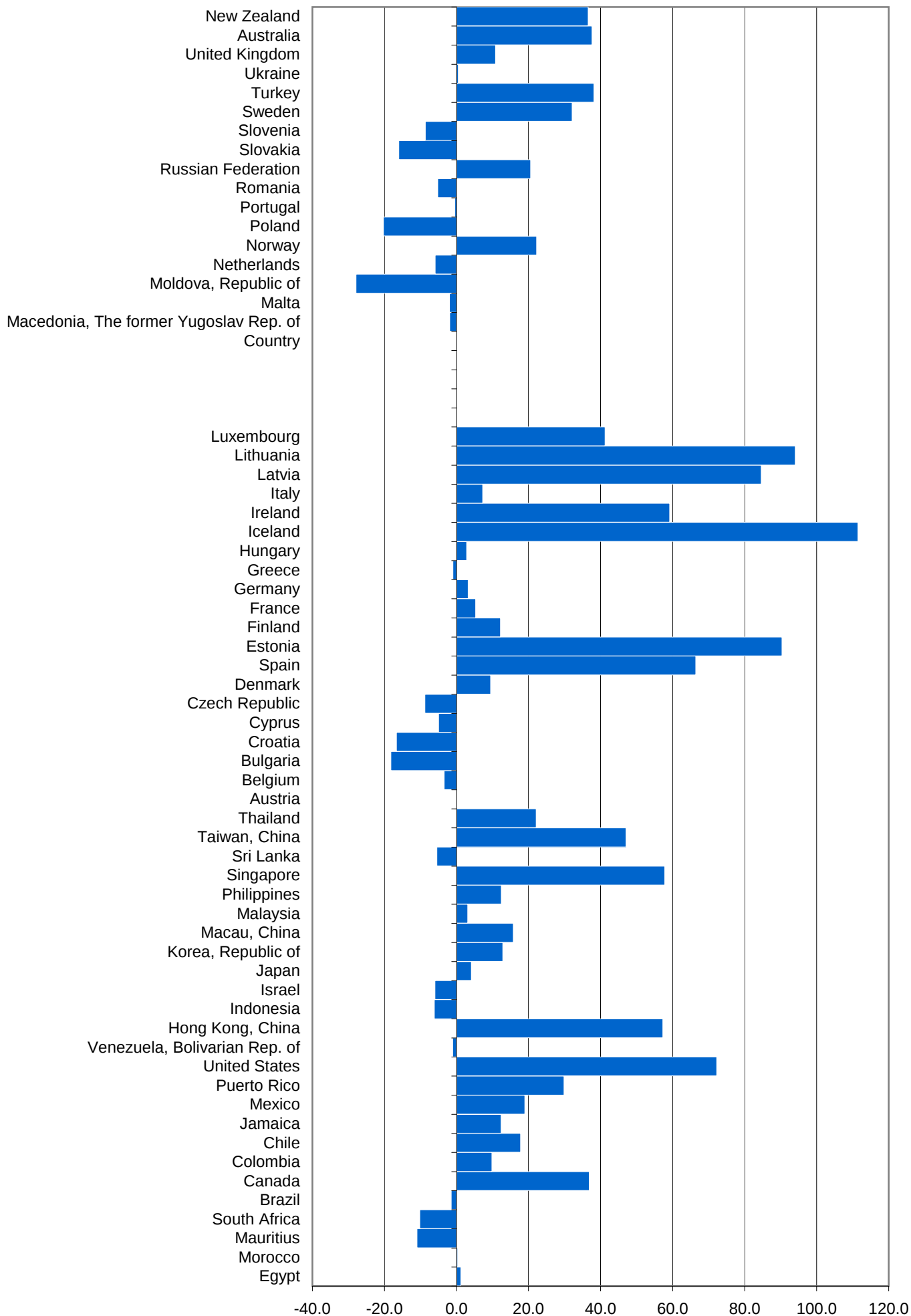

Percentage change over the same period of the previous year

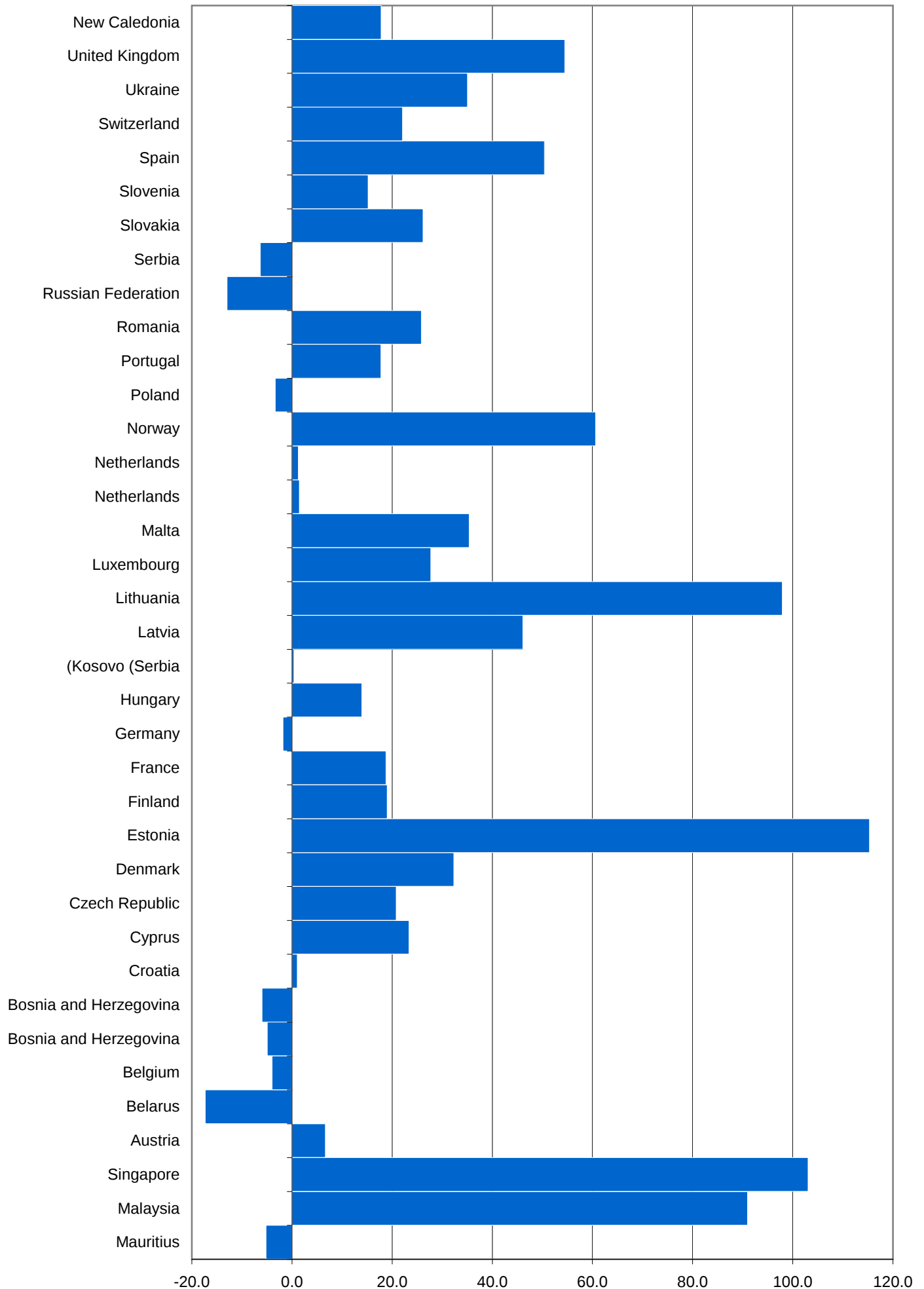

Percentage change over the same period of the previous year

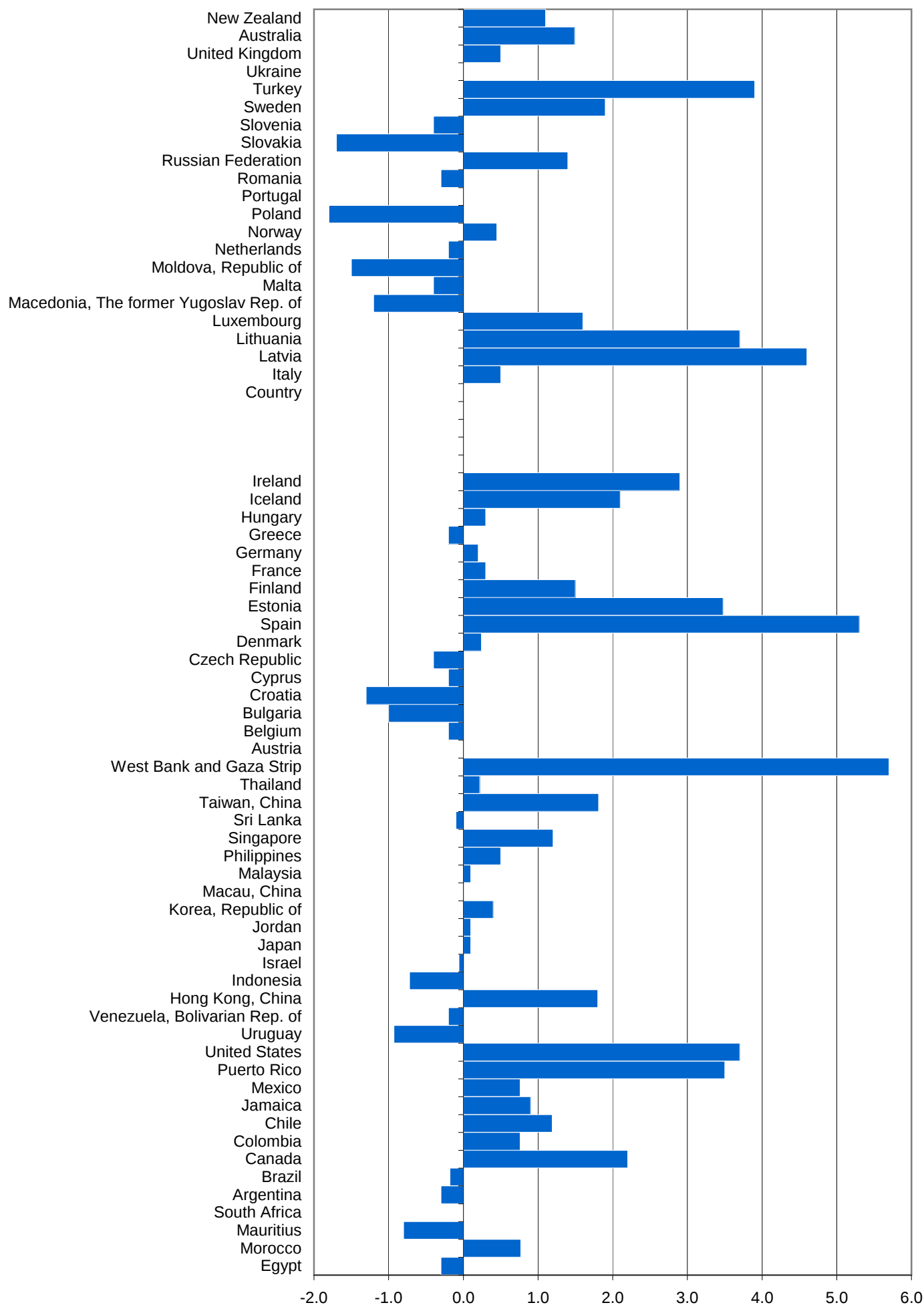

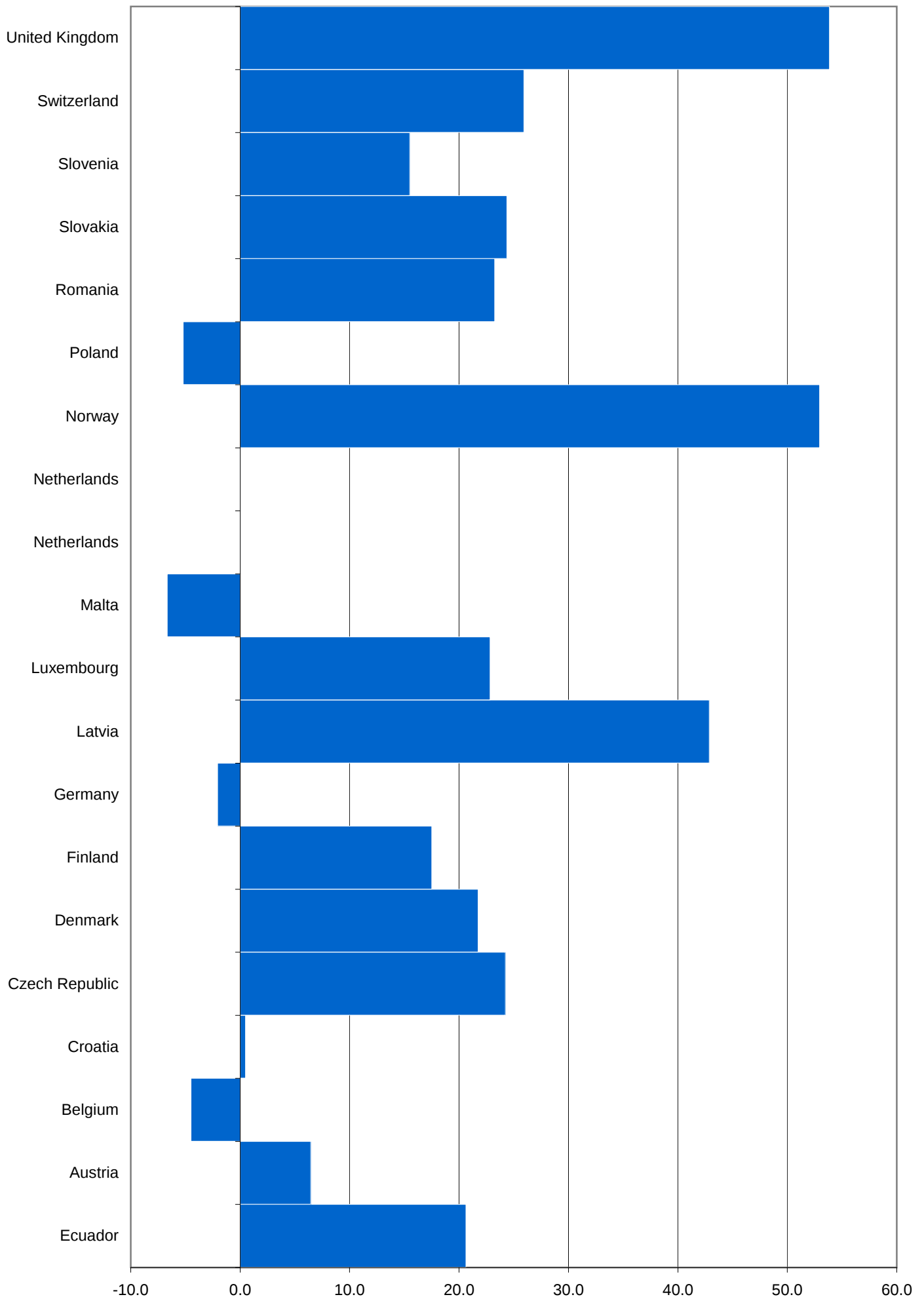
Graph 1c. Unemployment Rate

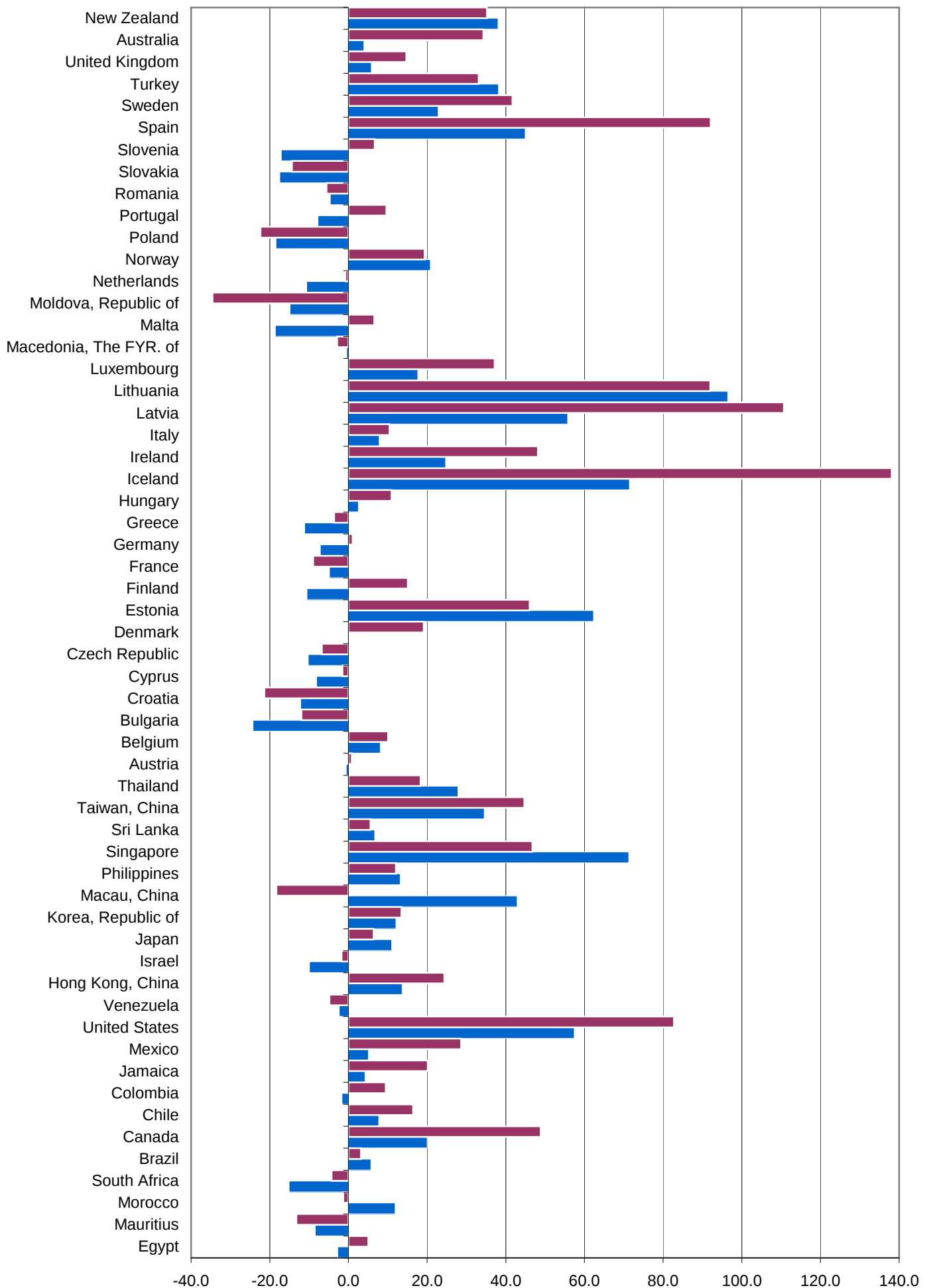
Graph 1e. Unemployment by sex
