China ratified the ILO Occupational Safety and Health Convention (No.155)



1.1 On 31 October, 2006, the Standing Committee of Chinese National People's Congress ratified the ILO Occupational Safety and Health Convention (NO.155). This marked the Chinese Government's commitment to the world community that China will, just like other ILO member countries, improve labor conditions and work environment, consistently raise worker's occupational safety and health level and accept worldwide supervision.



1.2 *Modern occupational safety* magazine made a special report for ratification of NO.155 in China. covering interviews of Ministry of Labor and Social Security, State Safety Work Administration, All-China Federation of Trade Union, China Enterprise Confederation, and ILO Beijing Office.






2. China celebrated "2007 World Day on Safety and Health at Work"

2.2 China's State Administration of Work Safety (SAWS) combining with ILO, held a keynote report session on 27 April, 2007, in Beijing. Its theme was Safety and Health Workplace Making Decent Work a Reality— Concerning Employees' Safety and Occupational Health in Mining in China.





4.3 During the week of science and technology activity in May, National ILO/CIS Centre for China distributed the books to the community denizens.








National ILO/CIS Centre for China hopes to cooperate with ILO /CIS and other CIS national centres in the field of occupational safety and health in the future.
