Research and training

- As a scientific institution within the Spanish Ministry of Science and Innovation, the work of the National School of Occupational Medicine is focussed on **research and training in the field of occupational health and occupational diseases.**
- **CISDOC database** is very much used in the one-year course that the National School of Occupational Medicine offers as part of the **training programme for general practitioners to become occupational health physicians.**

Advantages of CISDOC

- One major reason is that it gives access to original documents, which is not possible through other databases.
- It is the main information source for doctors preparing their theses and research projects on different subjects related to occupational medicine.
- In this respect, the type of information contained in CISDOC is very specialized and unique.
- A simplification of CISDOC interface would be very positive in order to increase the number of users.
