26 April, from 12:00 to 14:00:

Colleagues are invited to run in the collective ILO London Marathon, which will consist of laps around the lake at R3. Runners should be sponsored by colleagues whose contribution will depend on the number of laps run. The contribution per lap is SFR 2.-. 28 April, at 12:30:

All colleagues are invited to join a walk as an expression of solidarity with workers living with HIV/AIDS. The walk will start on the R1 Lawn in front of the Staff Lounge and will cover a route of approximately 1 km around the ILO building. All those interested are kindly requested to assemble at 12:20 and also make a contribution to the fund-raising campaign.

28 April, at 16:00:

A brief ceremony will be held at the Staff Lounge, during which the Staff Union will present a cheque to Andy Harvey for the amount collected.
