Dear Mr. Takala,

This is to inform you that ILO Office in Islamabad had commemorated the above mentioned day in Lahore with the All Pakistan Federation of Trade Union (APFTU) and in Karachi with the Workers and Employers Bilateral Council of Pakistan (WEBCOP).

In Karachi the WEBCOP had organised a Workshop on "Safety and Health Culture in a Globalized World". The workshop was inaugurated by the Minister of Labour, Transport, Commerce and Industries and was attended by 100 participants from the employers, workers and universities. Three papers were presented during the workshop:

1. Need & Importance of Health and Safety Training in the Industry; by a Health, Safety & Environment Consultant,
2. Accident Prevention Reduce Losses; by the Joint Director, Occupational Safety and Health, Ministry of Labour, and
3. Safety and Health at Work in Context to Globalization; by Chief Executive of MAX-Save Engineering.

The presentations were followed by open discussions. The meeting was covered by local TVs and journalists. I was interviewed by two TV stations.

WEBCOP also printed 3 different OSH posters (1000 each) which are being distributed to the factories. I am sending you the papers and samples of posters by pouch.
