




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# Vanuatu NSDP Baseline Survey

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# I. SURVEY DESCRIPTION

## Basic information

The Vanuatu National Sustainable Development Plan (**NSDP**) **Baseline Survey** is an expanded Household Income and Expenditure Survey (HIES) which will set the regional standard for HIES collection tailored to the needs of the national government. It is inclusive of the new Pacific standard HIES core questionnaire developed by the Secretariat for the Pacific Community Statistics for Development Division in close collaboration with the World Bank, the ILO, the FAO, and other international stakeholders. It accomplishes the task of collecting data relevant to inform the main macroeconomic indicators used for cost and poverty analysis for Vanuatu. Beyond that, the NSDP Baseline Survey has built into the core HIES questionnaire a number of questions and modules targeting needs outlined in the NSDP Monitoring and Evaluation (M&E) Framework launched in July 2017, as well as relevant needs outlined in the United Nations Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs).

The NSDP was launched in January 2017 and is the government's central policy framework. The M&E Framework associated with the NSDP uses information from the entire statistical system, including institutional and administrative data. The VNSO is the main producer responsible for roughly 25% of the indicators outlined in the NSDP M&E Framework. These indicators require data collected through household surveys and censuses, as well as data regularly reported through statistical publications (e.g. National Accounts, GDP Analysis, Tourism Statistics, Quarterly Statistical Indicators, etc.). The NSDP Baseline Survey will collect data to inform all indicators relevant for household level collection in order to update and rebase macroeconomic measures, update social indicators, and introduce new variables for analysis as demanded in the NSDP M&E Framework and UN SDGs.

This questionnaire is in paper form for consultation purposes only. The survey will be conducted using tablet-based data entry using Survey Solutions software. The VNSO will make the necessary changes to the questionnaire identified by national partners directly to the software programme prior to field testing. The verification process is meant to allow all national stakeholders an opportunity to review the draft questionnaire, ask any questions they may have about the questionnaire and survey methodology, and propose additional questions for consideration to include in the questionnaire. It is important all government agencies, national partners and aid donors are given an opportunity to review all survey materials prior to the start of a national survey. We are hopeful to have full engagement from the Vanuatu Statistical System in order to ensure our output is relevant and useful.
